

## Key Stage 2 Test and Teacher Assessments

In 2016, the new more challenging national curriculum, which was introduced in 2014, was assessed by new tests and interim frameworks for teacher assessment. Results are no longer reported as levels: each pupil receives their test results as a scaled score and teacher assessments based on the standards in the interim framework. The expected standard in the tests is a scaled score of 100 or above. In addition, the Department for Education (DfE) have set the threshold for the higher standard in 2016 to be 110.

Please note, that children sitting key stage 2 tests in 2016 were the first to be taught and assessed under the new national curriculum. The expected standard has been raised and the accountability framework for schools has also changed. These changes mean that the expected standard this year is higher and not comparable with the expected standard used in previous year's statistics. Due to the changes, the figures for 2016 presented below are not comparable to those for earlier years and hence no time series statistics are presented below for this reason.
