# Topic 1 Ancient Greece



#### History

In History we will:

- explain how Ancient Greek life has influenced the Western World today
- learn about Ancient Greek myths
- describe how the decisions we make in Parliament have been around for some time
- find out about the different Greek Gods

# Topic 2 Electricity



#### Science

In Science we will:

- identify common appliances that run on electricity
- recognise potential dangers of electricity
- construct a simple series electric circuit
- identify and name the basic part in a series circuit, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers
- conduct an investigation to determine which materials are conductors.

Our main focus will be on fiction.

We will:

- read and explore a variety of texts, including 'The Water Horse' and 'Journey'
- explore the features of myths and stories set in imaginary worlds
- explore characterisation
- create settings

We will also explore a range of poetry including Kennings.

### Number and Place Value

#### We will:



- Round whole numbers to 10,000 to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000
- Count backwards through zero to include negative numbers
- Multiply two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using formal written layout
- Recognise and use factor pairs and commutativity in mental calculations.

<u>Computing</u>	Computing Digital Literacy: We will work together to create a document on the network and on the school website using hyperlinks and images. We will use editing tools to ensure work is clear and error free (spell check, find and replace).
